Affordable Housing: Dublin City Council plans to reduce the prices of its affordable homes BY JOANNE O'CONNOR

In Belmayne, North Dublin, a two-bed apartment is on sale for €272,000 on the open market and €270,000 at the Affordable sale price

ublin City Council is stepping up to the plate and taking on the developers to get rid of its excess housing stock and it's all good news for potential buyers.

Following a meeting earlier this week, the council plans to reduce the 'sale price of its existing affordable housing stock'. Although it has yet to clarify the discount, it is believed that up to 25 per cent could be

slashed from property prices already reduced by up to 35 per cent, in an effort to compete with deals from developers.

The current Affordable Housing scheme allows buyers who do not have the income to meet a standard mortgage to buy a house at a reduced price - usually between 30 and 35 per cent cheaper - with the local authority making up the difference in cost.

The local authority retains ownership of the portion of the property they funded, usually around

Even more affordable

30 per cent. The council also plans to implement a new marketing strategy for Affordable Housing including allowing it to sell homes to nonpanel purchasers who meet the criteria for the scheme in areas where large amounts of new properties remain vacant.

And it appears a downturn in interest from buyers was what prompted the council to

In its Affordable Housing report, it was concerned with the large portion (43 per cent) of applicants who did not respond to its housing offers.

'This may be down to the current economic climate or that affordable housing is now less attractive to applicants,' the document stated. 'It should also be highlighted that affordable applicants are now moving to purchase properties on the private market as there may be little difference between the affordable price and market price.

In the Royal Canal Park development in Ashtown, Dublin 15, two-bed apartments were originally offered for private sale at €375,000 and at an affordable discount price of €264,000, or €111,000, lower.

The same units are now available for €266,000, a difference of just €2,000 on the affordable home.

For the discount, the affordable home buyer is locked into a deal with the council for 20 years.

Fine Gael's housing spokesman Terence Flanagan, has said the council needs to 'get real and drop

their prices quickly'. 'While this announcement is to be welcomed, questions need to be asked about the long delay in the Council responding to the fall in property prices,' he said.

'All councils must follow suit and cut the prices of their affordable homes so that the huge waiting lists can be tackled,' Mr Flanagan added.

A discounted price for the affordable units is agreed on the market price which is generally in the region of 30 to 35 per cent in Dublin.

However buyers of affordable homes must pay a 'claw-back' to the council of the percentage of discount they received if they sell their house within 20 years.
